This would be the first NASCAR race run under the new sponsorship name Nextel Cup seeing the end of a legacy with Winston no longer in the sport. Dale Earnhardt Jr. would win an emotional victory in the 500, after passing frequent Capital Region invader Tony Stewart with 18 laps to go. Dale Jr.'s win came 6 years to the day that his late father, the legendary Dale Earnhardt Sr., won his only Daytona 500 victory in his well documented 20th try.

Daytona wasn't the only place to see some racing in the Florida sunshine as Speed weeks, the annual week long spectacle of speed leading up to the Daytona 500. Some of our own local drivers headed south to kick off there 2004 season as the DIRT Florida tour made its stop at the Volusa Speedway in Baberville.

Defending 2003 Lebanon Valley Speedway Champion Brett "The Jet" Hearn got things started with a win on the opening night 30 lap feature event. Fellow Valley regular JR Heffner of Averill Park piloted his brightly colored #74 machine to victory lane at Volusia. Hearn and Heffner finished 2nd and 4th respectively in the final Florida tour point standings. Other locals to make there way to the warmer weather was Chris Moore and "Chic" Chandler, though both didn't fare as well.

Speaking of the Lebanon Valley speedway, what does Owner and Promoter Howie Commander have in store for the 1/2 mile high-banked dirt super speedway this season? Well, I think the question has to be what doesn't he?
