Is it a sport? Well, no. Officially, it is not.

Is it pretty clear these ladies are hard working and dedicated athletes? Of that, there is no doubt.

In fact, spend a little time with the Treasures, the dance team that performs during Albany Conquest games, and you will be surprised by just how focused and dedicated these women are. There are 25 members of the dance team. Nine are veterans returning from last season. The other 16 team members were added after a series of open tryouts was in the Capital District earlier this year. A look at the resumes of these dancers may have some surprises.

"Our dancers are very professional," states Carla Domenico, the Treasures' choreographer and director.

Domenico has been the Treasures' director for two years. During that time, she's worked with dancers whose backgrounds include law school, doctoral degrees, and teaching. In addition to stellar dance resumes, their athletic accomplishments include Division I soccer, swimming, basketball and figure skating.

"We keep our dancers working pretty hard during the season," Domenico continued. "Being part of the team is a lot of work. In addition to the physical side – staying in shape and practicing the choreography – there is lot of extra community service work that is required."

The Treasures hit the road often, appearing at a wide variety of events from Christmas Tree Lightings to Super Bowl Parties; as Domenico says: "We want them out in the community. We see them as role models."

Because of the demands put on the dancers, interviewing and auditioning new team members is an important job. At each of the team's three open tryouts,

Conquest media director Brad Wilson estimated that over 100 women came out. For Domenico, the critical trait she looks for is passion, above and beyond dancing.

"It is actually easy during the interview and while watching the dancing to tell who really has a passion for dancing," she explains.

"You can get a feel from the things they say and the questions they ask. The right people come across energetic and gung-ho."

The Treasures dancers are an integral part of the Conquest's game day festivities. They perform several dances, each with a unique routine and costume. Domenico's routines are primarily influenced by jazz and hip-hop.

Before the game begins, the Treasures have an opening dance to pump up Conquest fans and then continue promoting team spirit with sideline routines during the game. At halftime, the girls per-

form a professionally choreographed show, which includes dancing, kicking and tumbling. In addition, the Treasures remain on the field after the game for a post-game autograph session.
